"It is for freedom that Christ has set you free." Galatians 5:1

I. We Are in a War

- A. Two battles are involved in experiencing lasting freedom:
 - 1. The battle to be set free
 - 2. The battle to stay free!
- B. The battle for our freedom is part of the normal Christian life. **There are two misconceptions**:
 - 1. When you accepted Christ, the battle was over. Proof that is not so:
 - a. *"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh."* (1 Corinthians 10:3)
 - b. "Put on the full armor of God so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil." (Ephesians 6:11)
 - c. *"From the days of John the Baptist until now, the Kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and violent men take it by force."* (Matthew 11:12)
 - d. "These things I have spoken to you so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)
 - 2. If you leave Satan alone, he will leave you alone.
 - a. *"All who came before Me are thieves and robbers."* (John 10:8)
 - b. "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy." (John 10:10)
 - c. The thief is Satan, and his main goal is to steal, kill, and destroy you.

II. A Battle Is Going on For Your Life and Your Freedom

There is a very real enemy that is out to steal, kill, and destroy you. You are not a hopeless victim in this battle. You have weapons that are divinely powerful to defeat this enemy.

"For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses." (2 Corinthians 10:4)

- A. **The first battle: The battle to be set free**. *Restoring the Foundations* deals with closing four doors during a ministry session.
 - 1. **The first door that must be closed:** The door of generational pressure that comes down through your family line.

"I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me." (Exodus 20:5)

Robert Henderson, who teaches on the Courts of Heaven, describes **iniquity** as the sin in your bloodline.

2. The second door that must be closed are the lies we believe.

"Stop imitating the ideals and opinions of the culture around you, but be inwardly transformed by the Holy Spirit through a total reformation of how you think. This will empower you to discern God's will as you live a beautiful life, satisfying and perfect in His eyes." (Romans 12:2, TPT)

"Don't you know that when you allow even a little lie into your heart, it can permeate your entire belief system?" (Galatians 5:9, TPT)

3. The third door that must be closed are the wounded places in our heart.

"He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted." (Luke 4:18, NKJV)

4. The fourth door that must be closed is the oppression that comes from our enemy.

"Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, and

do not give the devil an opportunity." (Ephesians 4:26-27)

B. The second battle for freedom is knowing how to keep the doors closed as you walk out your freedom.

Let's look at several things that would benefit you as you battle to stay free in Christ.

1. The first thing you need to stay free is to have a good defense.

"Put on the full armor of God." (Ephesians 6:11)

2. Part of any good defense is to **understand your enemy**.

"... so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes." (2 Corinthians 2:11)

"Put on the full armor of God so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil." (Ephesians 6:11)

3. Part of a good defense is to **guard your mind.** The battleground for this battle is in the mind.

"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, ⁴for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. ⁵We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ." (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

III. Boundaries

Boundaries determine what you will allow in and what you keep out.

A. For countries to stay safe, they have to put up good boundaries.

- 1. Activities
- 2. People

B. For countries to remain free, they need to have good allies.

C. Every free country has some form of a constitution that provides guidelines for the new freedom.

"For the Word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12)
